## **HESI A2 Admission Exam – Medical Imaging**



### **Exam Information**

The HESI A2 Admission Exam is a timed, computerized test which is usually completed in 3-4 hours. There is a 4.5-hour time limit. All applicants for the Diagnostic Medical Sonography, Medical Radiography and Magnetic Resonance Imaging AAS programs are required to take this exam and submit their score sheet with the program application. Submitted scores will be verified by the Application Review Committees.

There are five sections of the HESI A2 exam required: Reading Comprehension, Grammar, Vocabulary/General Knowledge, Math, and Anatomy/Physiology. Applicants must also complete the Learning Style section; however, it will not be scored. There is not a minimum score requirement; however, a cumulative score of 70% and a score of 70% in each of the five sections is highly recommended.

Applicants are permitted to take the HESI A2 Exam twice (HESI Attempt 1 & HESI Attempt 2) per academic year (September – August). However, HESI A2 Attempt 1 must be taken first and HESI A2 Attempt 2 cannot be taken until 30 days after HESI Attempt 1 was taken.

- If an applicant takes HESI A2 Attempt 1 twice in a given academic year, the HESI scores for the second HESI A2 Attempt 1 will be invalid.
- If an applicant takes HESI A2 Attempt 2 twice in a given academic year, the HESI scores for the second HESI A2 Attempt 2 will be invalid.
- If an applicant takes HESI A2 Attempt 2 before the 30-day wait period after taking HESI A2 Attempt 1, the HESI A2 Attempt 2 scores will be invalid.
- If an applicant takes HESI A2 Attempt 2 before taking HESI A2 Attempt 1, the student will not be permitted to take HESI A2 Attempt 1.

Applicants must take the HESI A2 Exam at San Jacinto College to apply for one of the Medical Imaging programs. The Exam must have been taken within 2 years of the program application deadline.

## Signing Up for an Exam Date and Time:

The HESI A2 Exam will be administered in the Health Science Building on Central Campus. Students may sign up for a HESI A2 Exam date/time during their respective Program Information Session. Please visit the Program's webpage for Information Session dates. Please see the exam dates/times for the 2024-2025 academic year that will be offered below:

• Go to the <u>Medical Radiography</u>, <u>Diagnostic Medical Sonography</u>, or <u>Magnetic Resonance Imaging</u> webpage to determine which program Information Session you will be attending. Register for, attend, and sign in at the Information Session. After the Information Session, you will receive an email with instructions and a link to sign up for a HESI A2 Exam time slot.

- Go to the link for "sign up" and sign up for **ONE** exam time.
  - Applicants who do not appear for the HESI A2 Exam after signing up will not be permitted to sign up for another time slot for the remainder of the academic year (9/1/2024-8/31/2025). If you are unable to attend a session you signed up for, you must remove your sign up at least 48 hours before the scheduled exam time. Emergencies will be addressed on a case-by-case basis and documentation may be required.
  - Applicants who do not fill in all data completely and correctly in the sign up will be deleted and not permitted
    in the exam regardless of payment (ex. first and last name, email).
- Register for Elsevier account (instructions attached) DO NOT FORGET USERNAME AND PASSWORD, you will need this on exam day.
- Register for HESI assessment on Elsevier website (instructions attached)
- Receive an email with the payment link from the Medical Imaging Department (1 to 2 weeks prior to exam date)
- Pay for Exam (instructions attached).
- Bring your Government issued picture ID and Payment Receipt to your exam: *Examinees will not be permitted in the exam without a Government issued Picture ID and a receipt of payment for exam.*
- Examinees will not be permitted into the exam if they did not attend and sign in at one of the program Information Sessions.
- Do not bring anything else with you into the exam testing area. Examinees will not be permitted anything in the testing area, including cell phones and/or calculators. If a student must carry a bag/purse, the item will be left unattended at the front of the testing area. Faculty are not responsible for the safety of those items. Students may place their required ID and receipt in their pocket.
- Examinees will be provided a pencil and scratch paper. All items will be returned prior to leaving the exam area.
- Examinees will be permitted to take a restroom break only between exam sections.
- Students needing accessibility accommodations should go to <u>Accessibility Services</u> to apply for accessibility
  accommodations and then contact the Medical Imaging Department for further instructions and
  testing appointments. DO NOT sign up for the HESI A2 exam under the "sign up" link.
- Instructions for HESI A2 Attempt 2 will be provided at the HESI A2 Attempt 1 exam session.


- 1. To create a student account on Evolve, start by visiting the Evolve site at


4. In the window that drops down, click the **Create account** link.






- 5. Select the **Student** button and enter your **First name**, **Last name**, and **Email address** (your institutional/school email address is preferred, or a personal one if not available).


